


A special trim tab works beautifully with the ConvexY hull to improve planing times and sculpt

01 RUNDOWN

Tigé goes all out on this all-new 24Vé. It's now the top-of-the-line model for the Texas-based company. This boat seems as big as Texas itself, especially when you're kicking back in the wrap-around lounge and that passenger-side bench seems to stretch longer than Houston's main man Yao Ming. Besides the size comes the style. The bow alone may

have the sweetest contoured seating out there, all reclining, cocooning swoops. Knowing that riders need their refreshment, Tigé packed three coolers onto the boat. Plus there are a lot of other rare features that make this flagship boat a real standout. And we haven't even mentioned the wakes yet.

03 WAKE SHAPE

Tigé excels at creating wakes ideal for riding. All the right characteristics are there, especially a sharp definition and a crisp peak. Any level of rider will find something to love about these wakes. Tigé pushes its TAPS tab and ConvexV hull instead of a ballast system, which is great for most beginners to intermediate riders. The TAPS turned up all the way is enough for them. But advanced riders almost always want monster wakes, which are easily created with extra ballast on top of the 24Vé's already massive 4,320-pound weight.



04 RIDER INPUT

THIS BOAT IS BIG COMFORTABLE.
